This CCIBI course will systematically examine the books of James, 1 & 2 Peter, 1, 2 & 3 John and Jude. These general epistles are filled with practical golden truths that will impact your everyday living for Jesus. This class is designed for a verse by verse teaching of the texts which will help you understand the context of why these particular books were written and what it means to you today as a Christ follower. This class will be taught by Elder Michael Gustave. Michael Gustave is a graduate of Hartford State Technical College, University of Hartford and Central Connecticut State University. Michael, a former Electrical Engineer and a member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE). He is Certified in Mathematics and Adult Education for the State of Connecticut and currently teaches Adult Education classes and consults. Michael is an approved Volunteer for the State of Connecticut Department of Corrections and performs religious services to inmates. Elder Gustave is deeply passionate about God's Word and is a very charismatic communicator.

## NT208 The Book of Hebrews

This course will undergo a thorough study of Hebrews, beginning with an analysis of the author, date, readers, purpose, outline, and introduction of the book. Throughout the course, care is taken to examine the meaning of each passage to the first readers, identify timeless principles, and apply them for today's readers. The study seeks to integrate passages with two themes: Christ and Christianity are superior to Judaism (Heb. 1-10); a superior Revealer, Mediator, and covenant demand the highest level of commitment (Heb. 11-13). You don't want to miss this exciting study! And there is a bonus! By understanding the book of Hebrews, you will gain a deeper understanding and appreciation for the Old Testament. Rev. Donnie Capps is the Academic Dean of the Bible Institute and Director of Community Care at Crossroads Community Cathedral. He holds a Bachelor's of Science in church ministries from Southwestern Assemblies of God University and a Master's of Divinity from Assemblies of God Theological Seminary, specializing in chaplaincy ministry. His passion is preaching and teaching the Word of God. Also, Ms. June Thomas will be co-teaching this class. June holds a Bachelor's in Communications from Emerson College and is a graduate of Oral Roberts University with a Master's degree in Christian Education.
